#### **Field Visit Questions**

31 May - 1 June, 2016

Below is a list of key issues that we hope can guide your thinking through our field visits in Concepción and Temuco, Chile and help you link the field visit observations with the later discussions. It is not an exhaustive list and is only meant to be a reference for you to develop more focused questions that can benefit our broader discussion later in our dialogue on Tree Plantations in the Landscape.

- What has been the role of tree plantations in the landscape?
- What externalities are associated with the development and management of tree plantations in this region?
- What are the main activities taking place in and around tree plantations in the region?
- What are the main activities or local initiatives affected by the management of tree plantations?
- How does the design and implementation of tree plantations affect the role they play within the landscape?
- What approaches are being taken to enable good governance and inclusive development? Where are the areas for improvement?
- In what ways do different stakeholder groups interact with tree plantations? What opportunities, benefits and challenges do they derive from these interactions?
- What is the role that the government has played in the design and implementation of tree plantations and in the communitybusiness relationship?
- How should tree plantations be managed to contribute to the sustainable development goals (SDGs)?
- What are the main challenges related to the interaction of the beliefs and aspirations of the Mapuche people and the tree plantation sector?
