

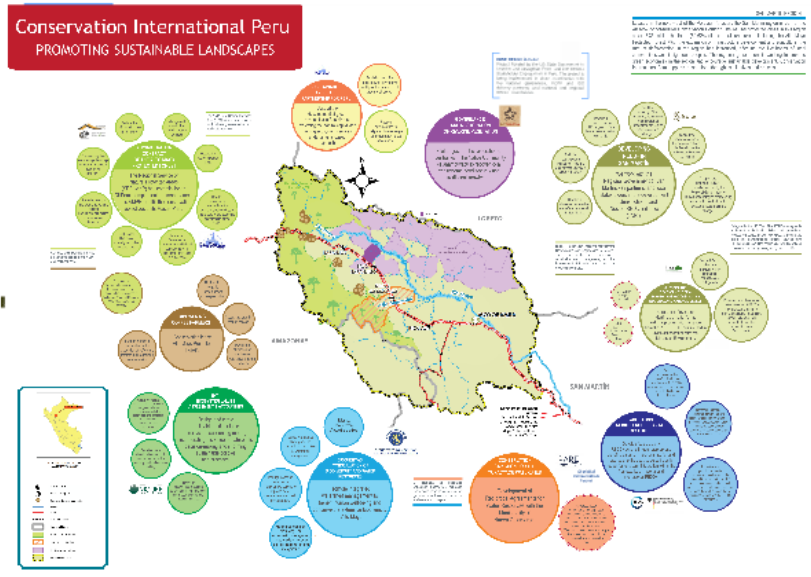

## ADMINISTRATION CONTRACT OF THE ALTO MAYO PROTECTED FOREST

The Nacional Service of Natural Protected Areas (SERNANP) has commissioned CI-Peru to implement the management of the AMPF to fulfill the conservation objectives of its Master Plan.

Update the AMPF's Master Plan.

Promote, regulate and manage the usage of natural renewable resources in the AMPF.

Develop compensation mechanisms for environmental services to contribute to the economic sustainability of the AMPF.

Formalize tourism and extend its benefits to local populations minimizing environmental impacts.

Establish the AMPF as a nationally recognized research site.

Implement Conservation Agreements with local populations living inside the AMPF and its buffer zone.



Currently, we have more than 600 agreements signed in the AMPF and its Buffer Zone.


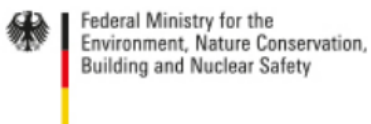
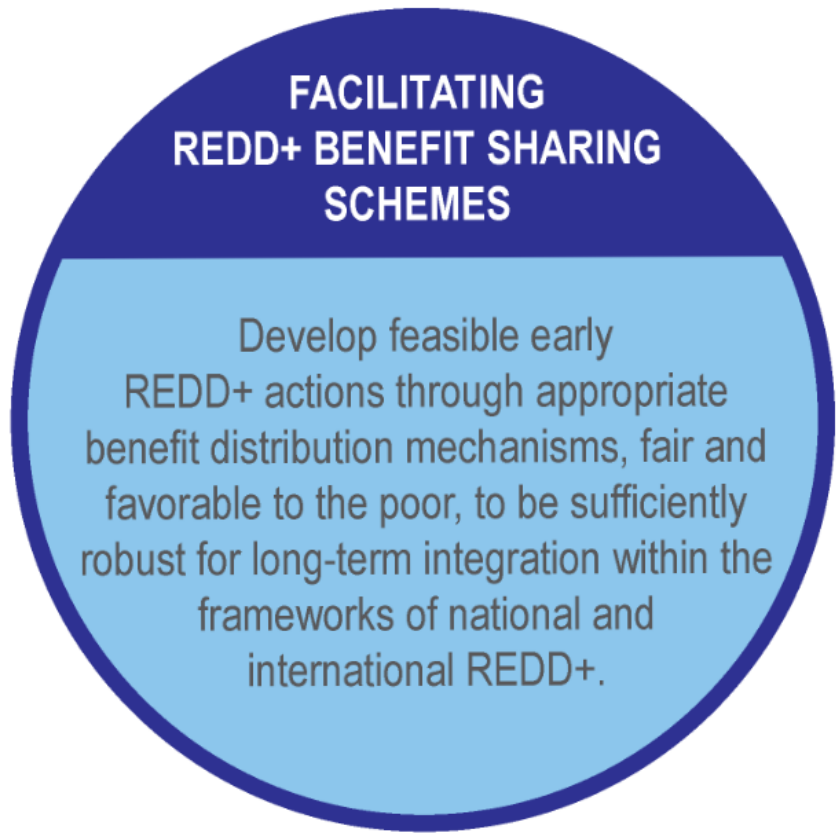

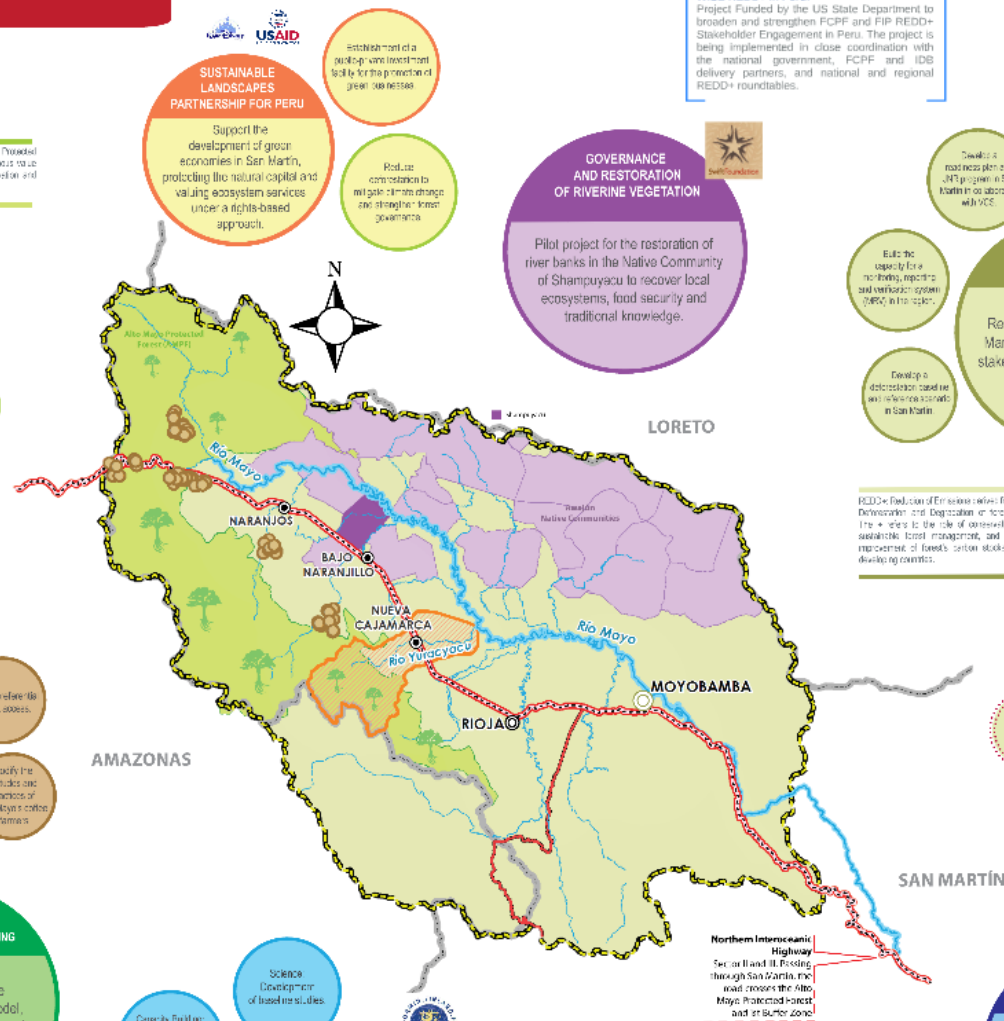


# Conservation International Peru

## PROMOTING SUSTAINABLE LANDSCAPES

Located in the northwest of the Peruvian Amazon, the San Martín region is part of the Abiseo-Condor-Kutuku Conservation Corridor. The natural protected areas in this region cover 3.35 million hectares (64.62% of the total land area), including the Alto Mayo Protected Forest. With the expansion of infrastructure development and agriculture, the rate of deforestation in the region has increased, affecting the livelihoods of local communities and indigenous peoples. The regional government is working to promote green economies in the region and encourage sustainable development. Conservation International Peru supports these efforts through its initiatives and projects.

**WISE REDD+ in Peru:**  
Project funded by the US State Department to broaden and strengthen FCPF and FIP REDD+ Stakeholder Engagement in Peru. The project is being implemented in close coordination with the national government, FCPF and IDB delivery partners, and national and regional REDD+ roundtables.



**SUSTAINABLE LANDSCAPES PARTNERSHIP FOR PERU**  
Support the development of green economies in San Martín, protecting the natural capital and valuing ecosystem services under a rights-based approach.

**GOVERNANCE AND RESTORATION OF RIVERINE VEGETATION**  
Pilot project for the restoration of river banks in the Native Community of Shampuyacu to recover local ecosystems, food security and traditional knowledge.

Design and test a replicable and scalable ecosystem accounting model incorporating the value of nature into decision-making and informing sustainable policies and practices.

**CONSERVATION CAMPAIGN FOR THE YURACYACU WATERSHED**  
Development of Reciprocal Agreements for Water Resources with the Municipality of Nueva Cajamarca.

**FACILITATING REDD+ BENEFIT SHARING SCHEMES**  
Develop feasible early REDD+ actions through appropriate benefit distribution mechanisms, fair and favorable to the poor, to be sufficiently robust for long term integration within the frameworks of national and international REDD+.

**Update the AMPF's Master Plan**

REDD+ Evaluation of Emission sources from Deforestation and Degradation of forests (the + refers to the role of conservation in sustainable forest management, and the importance of forest carbon stocks in developing countries).

Requirements for REDD+: The REDD+ standards implement institutional, policy, and knowledge factors on activity and objectives to secure the social and environmental benefits resulting from REDD+, and to avoid the possible risks and social and environmental damages originating from REDD+.
