








## PROJECT VS. JURISDICTIONAL REDD+



Scale at which REDD+ is being implemented confuses approach and application of terminologies

- Specific projects may apply different terminologies as compared to jurisdictional implementation of REDD+ strategies.
- Our inconsistent use of terms makes it difficult to deliver clear & consistent messages to stakeholders who are not as involved in the daily discussions.
