Degradation



foster conservation, management of forests, and enhancement of forest carbon stocks.

Payment over results

NATIONAL CONTEXT

Mexico has a solid legal framework which establishes new tools and structures to tackle climate change challenges and which are also relevant for REDD+:

- General Law on Climate Change (LGCC)
- General Law of Sustainable Forestry Development (LGDFS)
- General Law of Rural Sustainable Development (LGDRS)
- National Strategy for Climate Change (ENCC)
- Special Program for Climate Change (PECC)
- Note Project on Emissions Reduction (ER-PIN)



MEXICOS VISION TOWARDS REDD+

Problem

- Both, deforestation and degradation are complex problems
- It's not a simple cause-effect relation
- Many causes are not related to the forestry sector

Solution

- Different level interventions that are all-encompassing.
- Impact direct and underlying causes.
- Develop integral frameworks for planning and land management that involve different actors in a collaborative fashion.






REDD+ IN MEXIO

Technical assistance.


Governance structures in the land unit.

Flexible mechanisms of financing.




