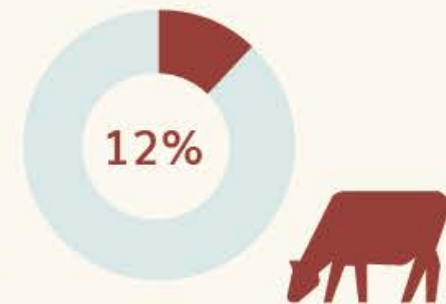

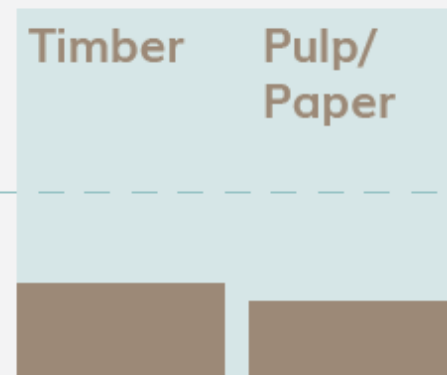

Integration of High Conservation Values (HCV),
High Carbon Stock (HCS) Forest and Free,
Prior and Informed Consent (FPIC)

High Carbon Stock Approach

- A methodology to delineate degraded land potentially suitable for plantations and crops from viable forest areas to be protected
- Designed for use in fragmented forest landscapes and mosaics in the humid tropics
- Integrates High Conservation Value and HCS assessments with processes related to Free, Prior, Informed Consent
- Use of licensed assessors to assure the quality of assessments

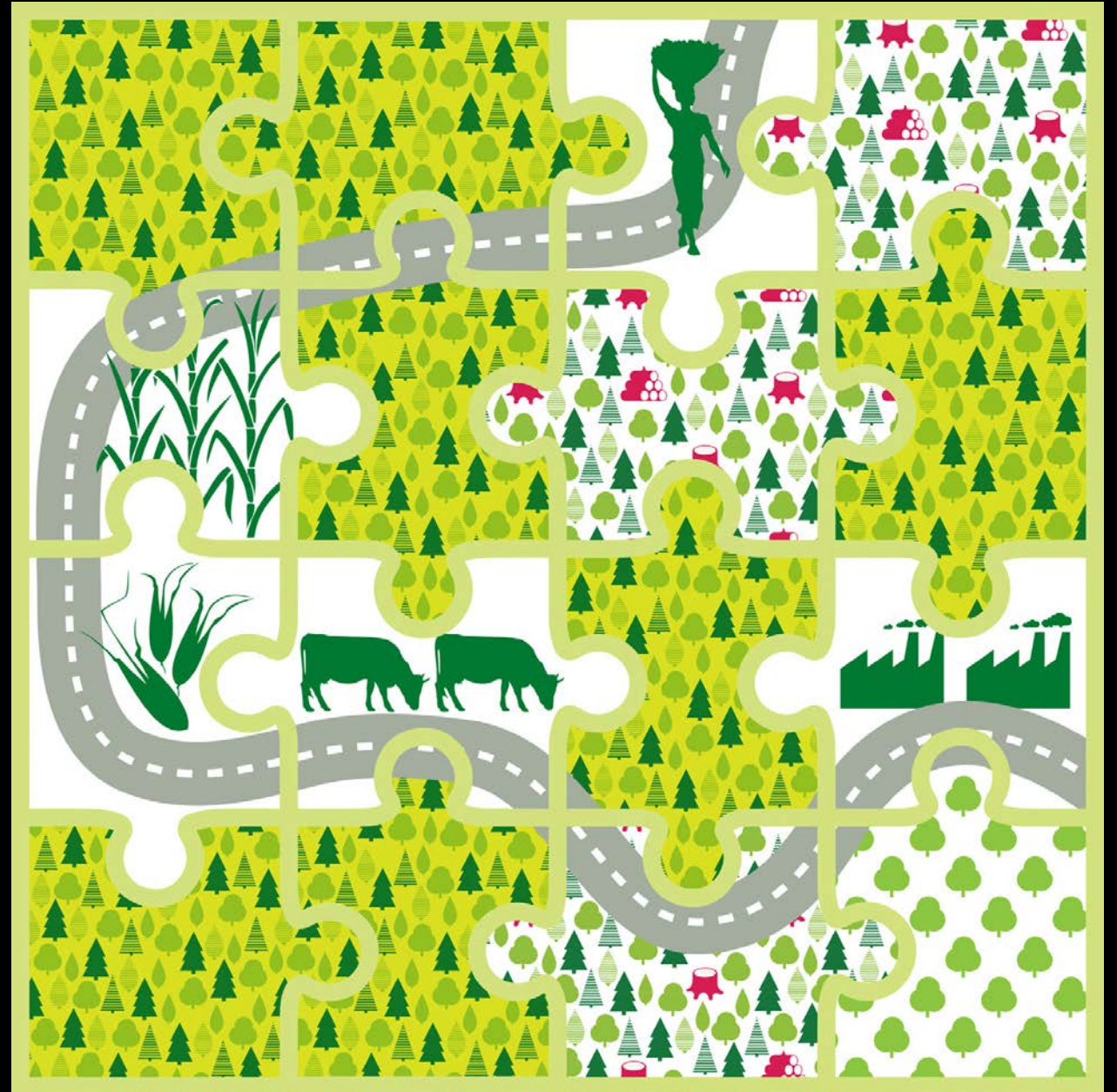


The Accountability Framework

Setting and implementing effective commitments on deforestation, land conversion, and human rights in responsible supply chains

- Making sense of complexity but allowing adaptation to different places and sectors
- Best practice guidance on implementing deforestation-free commitments
- Harmonising monitoring, verification and reporting

Because voluntary private sector initiatives alone will not be sufficient to bring deforestation rates down to near zero, a broader suite of governance and policy measures is needed to complement deforestation-free actions.
